

NOTICE TO SCHOOL DISTRICT

ARMED FORCES RECRUITER ACCESS TO STUDENT'S INFORMATION CONSENT FORM for Middle Schools and High Schools

Section 9528 (a)(2) of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965*, as amended by the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* provides that each school which receives funding under the No Child Left Behind Act "shall provide military recruiters the same access to secondary school students as is provided generally to post secondary educational institutions or the prospective employers" and that "a secondary **school student or the parent of the student** may request that the student's name, address and telephone listing "not be released without prior written parental consent." As noted, Section 9528 gives students the right to make this request.

_____ DO NOT _____ DO DISCLOSE my name, address and telephone number to military recruiters (Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, etc.) without prior written parental consent.

_____ DO NOT _____ DO DISCLOSE my name, address and telephone number to colleges and other educational institutions without prior written parental consent.

_____ DO NOT _____ DO DISCLOSE my name, address and telephone number to prospective employers without prior written parental consent.

Note to student and parent: This form can be signed by students, parents, or both. We recommend both students and parents decide this together. This form must be submitted at the time of registration for a school year and re-submitted each year at enrollment.
